✂️🖋️ In the Classroom...

Literacy: The students will continue to practice doing their 5 literacy Workstations **INDEPENDENTLY** so that I am able to meet with small groups. In these workstations students are Reading to Self from books they chose in their special Book Boxes, doing word hunts with a partner, making words with playdough, beads, stamps, and sticky string, listening to stories on Raz Kids, and Working on Writing in their writing journals.

Math: students have been learning how to identify odd and even numbers, how to identify and read number words, and how to subitize ten-frames, tally marks, dice, dominos, and dots. This means they can look at a picture and can quickly tell what number the picture is showing without having to count. We are also learning routines of how to complete our Math Journals and how to play partner games.

Science: The students are learning what scientists do & have been making their own observations using their 5 senses. This week we will continue making observations by going on a nature walk and will be observing different animals on a web cam.
