This week the students will have their 2nd week of spelling words to practice. A Word Work Menu can be found in your child's binder for ideas on how you can practice spelling words at home if you choose. The students will have a test on all 10 words on Friday. Spelling words come home each Friday and tests will be on the following Friday.

Pumpkins In the next few weeks, we will be working on a special pumpkin project. Each student will need to bring in a medium sized craft pumpkin that can be found at any craft store. Keep in mind that the entire project will be done at school. We will just need you to supply the pumpkin by Friday, Oct. 6th.

Xxin the Classroom...

Literacy: We will be reading different fall themed stories to practice retelling the story elements: Character, Setting, Problem, and Solution. We will also focus on being able to retell details from our stories in order (SEQUENCE).

We have been working hard on reviewing the formation of all our uppercase and lowercase letters for handwriting! We are also beginning to write in our special first grade journals to learn more about what good writer's do. Our focus has been on making sure to begin our sentences with a capital letter and to end them with a punctuation mark.

Math: The students have been learning different partner games in math to review number sense concepts. We have been learning the difference between odd and even numbers and using the number line to count-up and down.

Science: We will be finishing our learning about what scientists do and the different kinds of tools scientists use by doing two final experiments. The students will be bringing their Science Notebooks home by the end of the week. Have them go through it with you, and share all of the things they learned about being a SCIENTIST!
